We want to give you special thanks for your continued prayers for us and support of the ministry in Peru. We definitely see the results of your prayers for us and for the ministry here. You are special people called by our Lord Jesus Christ to minister to His children. Thank you for your faithfulness to His calling. Thank you for your love for Him, for us, and for His children.

In August, Arthur, Ricardo Nattery, our lawyer, Aybar Tucno, the owner of the land that we will buy in Pachacutec, and Abram Campos, our agricultural engineer, went to check out the land. Arthur and Ricardo drove to San Martin, a small town in the jungle, and met with Aybar and Abram. The next day they traveled to the site and spent the night there to check it out. Everything looked good for buying the land, and they are now waiting for the papers from the public register to complete the purchase. Hopefully this will occur in mid-September. This is the first step in a project to create funds from Peruvian sources to help sustain the ministry here. If the Lord Jesus is willing, we hope to plant the first ten hectares next year. We really appreciate all the support and prayer that each of you has given for this project. Please continue to pray that everything that is done with the land will glorify the Lord Jesus Christ.

This gives us more time to pray and make a decision about where the Lord Jesus wants us to live. We haven't found a house that is appropriate for us yet, but we have found some lots that we could buy and build a house on. Please pray that we will do the will of God as we make this decision about where to live.

The Kid's Club in Pichcus is going well, but at times we lack teachers because many of them are studying in the university now. One Saturday we all played games and had a great time. Please pray that God will provide more teachers and helpers for this club, and that the children and teachers will have a true love and passion for the Lord Jesus Christ.
