The good thing is that God will always be with us and will always give us His strength, no matter what is happening in our lives.


This month was a busy month for us, and we enjoyed meeting with several of our supporters and are setting up times to meet with others. Our computers and phones were very old. Arthur has had to repair them several times over the past 12 years to keep them going. His computer was literally held together with tape and cardboard. Mary Alice was still using a flip phone we purchased 15 years ago. It was a great blessing that we were able to purchase new phones and computers. Arthur has been busy setting them up. Also, Arthur has been repairing things that need repair on our house in Marietta. Our daughter, Mary Beth, and her sons, Dominic and Royce, live in our house and Mary Beth has done a good job of taking care of it, but there are things she is not able to repair.

Arthur was able to get new glasses and can see much better. He has had a problem with his left eye that has been interfering with his vision in that eye. He was able to have that evaluated, and it was determined to be a leaking blood vessel in the retina caused by a hereditary problem. There is currently no treatment for this, but the doctor recommended taking Lysine, a vitamin, that seems to be helping. The doctor indicated that a possible treatment is supposed to be approved by the FDA very soon and might be available before we return to Peru.

The Peruvians seem to be doing a great job with the ministry in our absence. In December the participation online in the discipleship groups was a little lower than normal, but Beto says that they are going well. Two groups in the Huancayo area are meeting in person, and one group in Huancavelica is meeting in person. Beto and some other leaders conducted a three-day workshop for 12 new leaders and others that wanted to learn more about how to disciple others. Also, they visited and encouraged a group of teachers in the Casa de Oracion Quechua Church.

Nadia is a young girl who was born in Huancavelica. She is almost finished with her degree in industrial engineering. She is having a hard time because her fiancé, Paulo, broke up with her a couple of weeks ago, even though he had promised to marry her in 2022. Nadia began to see things in Paulo she hadn't seen before, and she began to doubt that she should marry him at all. After placing her trust in the Lord, her relationship with Paulo began to improve. He began to participate in one of Beto's discipleship groups online, but they don't know his intentions yet. Please pray that Nadia will have God's wisdom to make the right decision about her relationship with Paulo and that he will come to know the Lord Jesus Christ.

Beto was able to visit the farm this month to see how everything was going. Praise the Lord Jesus, the weather was very good. It stopped raining, and there was plenty of sun. The farm team was able to finish cutting the undergrowth around the cacao trees and was able to finish fumigating the plants to prevent them from getting a fungus that has been damaging the beans. They are expecting an additional small harvest of cacao in the next few weeks. In addition, the team finished planting the banana seedlings and started cutting back the under growth around the coffee.


Prayer Requests and Praises for January
