


Diego, Sara, and Isabella

Then in May Sara lost her job because the cosmetic business went bankrupt, but she found a job cleaning a house. The owner of the house, her husband, and her son contracted Covid-19, so Sara quit the job. She was thankful that she didn't get the virus from the family.

God gave Isabella the idea to make a different type of clothes – T-shirts, jogging outfits, and sweat suits for men. This clothing sold very well, and now she makes the same type of clothing for women. She even has an official page on Facebook, to sell even more. With God's help, she has opened a personal business, and He is blessing her abundantly. She says that she isn't looking to become rich with her business; she just wants to help kids, youth, and adults that don't have much money to know the Lord Jesus Christ and grow in Him. She is thankful to God for his help, protection, and provision during her time of trouble.

Rubén Salvatierra went through a class with us in evangelism years ago, and he now leads a discipleship group. In February he lost both of his parents to Covid-19. He told Beto that to die was a blessing for his parents, because they were both Christians. He said that God is comforting him and is the strength of his life. He will continue to follow Jesus each day. Please pray that God will comfort him and his family.

### **Prayer Requests for March**


1. Praise God. Ivan, the young man who lives with us, who has a virus, Bell's palsy, is almost completely healed. Please continue to pray for his complete healing.
