We want to give you special thanks for your continued prayers for us and support of the ministry in Peru. We definitely see the results of your prayers for us and for the ministry here. You are special people called by our Lord Jesus Christ to minister to His children. Thank you for your faithfulness to His calling. Thank you for your love for Him, for us, and for His children.

In January, we were privileged to participate in a wedding for one of our strongest workers, Edith Romero. She married Efraín Ramirez, who is from Huancavelica, and Pastor Alberto Fernandez shared a devotion during the wedding. It was a very pretty wedding in a Pentecostal Church, and we were the godparents of the couple. Generally the godparents of the couple are special to them in some way, and mainly their responsibility is to pray for the couple and to be the witnesses that sign the marriage certificate. Sometimes they also have the responsibility of paying for the wedding, but we didn’t have to do that. For a long time, Arthur and Pastor Alberto have wanted to start discipleship groups in Huancavelica, but they didn’t have a good contact to help them, but Edith is very strong in discipleship and has led many discipleship groups in Canta for years. Edith and Efraín are going to live in Huancavelica, and if it is God’s will, they will begin doing discipleship groups there. We praise God for what He is doing in the lives of Edith and Efraín, and that He has given us a way to begin discipleship in Huancavelica. Please pray that God will lead Edith and Efraín to people who will be open to study the Bible with them, and that they will adjustment quickly to being married.

She is a part of Arthur's Friday night discipleship group and a teacher in the Kid's Club; several times she has given powerful testimonies about how God has helped her during her life. She is also correcting the new Kid's Club lessons that Mary Alice has written recently. Please pray that God will continue to guide Rocio in everything that she does and that she will continue to grow in Him as well as the other participants that were in the leadership workshop.


