We hope that the Lord Jesus has been blessing you wonderfully during this past month, and that your life has been filled with His glorious riches and mercy. We are so thankful to God for you.

The Peruvian team under the leadership of Alberto, Pedro, and Darwin continued to work hard in the ministry in our absence. In January, besides conducting their normal discipleship groups, they also conducted a basic leadership workshop in Vista Alegre. There were supposed to be only 15 participants, but 45 people showed up. Nicole Salgado, a girl who is a senior in high school, shared the gospel presentation. Because she is so young, the participants in the workshop were impressed that God used her as He did. Please pray that God will continue to change people's lives in Vista Alegre to advance His Kingdom.

A workshop on evangelism was conducted in San Pedro to help prepare workers for the medical mission scheduled for June of this year. Alberto, Pedro, and Darwin also continued to advance the planning and preparations for the three medical missions that are scheduled for 2020. Please pray that our planning would be in accordance with the will of the Lord Jesus.

We have enjoyed visiting a number of supporters this month around the Atlanta, Georgia area. We love how God uses each of you to encourage us when we visit with you. We enjoy praying with you and getting to know your family. We wish we had time to visit with more of you. We had the privilege of speaking at Stonebridge Church and with the Joy Sunday School class, during this time, also. Our prayer is that God will always use what we share to touch at least one person for Him.

Our son-in-law, Oscar, is in Peru because his mother, Maria Luisa, isn't in good health, and is in the hospital. She suffers from multiple sclerosis, and is paralyzed. Please pray that God will heal her. We are helping our daughter, Mary Beth, by taking and picking up her boys from school while Oscar is in Peru.

Also, Mary Alice's mother, Mary Anne, has stage four lung cancer, and she is not doing well. Please pray that God will give His strength to Mary Alice's brother, Ronald, and his wife, Susan, as they care for her in Dallas, Texas, along with her caregivers. Please pray for healing for Mary Anne, and for her family, as they deal with the emotions that are part of this type of struggle.

God gave Arthur an opportunity to observe a healing prayer session with a ministry here in Marietta area. The methods used are similar to those we are using in Peru, but there were differences, as well. We will be praying about possibly incorporating what Arthur learned to make the ministry more fruitful in Peru. We are always looking for opportunities to improve our ministry skills.

Since we are expecting a significant harvest of coffee, starting in late February 2020, Arthur traveled with Leonard Scarboro to St. Louis, Missouri to visit with the owners of the Hudson Lermo Beverage Company, who want to purchase all of the coffee from the farm. It was a great meeting, and very encouraging. In addition, Leonard made it possible for Arthur to have the opportunity to meet with some of the leaders of Faith Church in St. Louis about the Peru ministry. They were interested in the ministry as well as possibly purchasing coffee from our farm through the Hudson Lermo Beverage Company. Please be in prayer that all of the details for this opportunity can be worked out.

Even though Arthur has turned over most all of the administrative duties to the Peruvian leaders, he still serves on the board of directors of the Fraternidad Misionera. The board held their annual meeting this month, and among other things, adopted the plan for this year's ministry activities, and it is a full schedule. They will conduct all three levels of the leadership workshops, many workshops on sexual purity, a microenterprise workshop, an evangelism workshop, and a children's ministry workshop. Beto has asked us to help with some of these workshops, so we are excited about that. In addition, plans were discussed for the continued move toward financial independence of the ministry, among other things. Please be in prayer that the Lord would use these plans to further His Kingdom in Peru during 2020.


We would appreciate it if you would pray for these ministry events that are planned for February:
