Pastor Beto, Pedro, and Darwin also conducted a basic leadership workshop in Huamancaca Chico, where we will be having the medical campaign in August, and two workshops with the youth from Chilca and San Lorenzo. Also, they have regular discipleship groups that they minister to each week.

We have some great news from Jorge Ayala. Bernabé, our main Asháninka leader and translator in the VRAEM, as well as being our Man of Peace in this area when we started this work in 2013, is continuing to grow in Christ and become a stronger leader. In the past, he just translated Spanish to Asháninka for our national missionaries when they taught the Asháninkas, but now Bernabé is discipling and training leaders among the Asháninka communities, and has developed a lot of respect among the people in the communities. In addition, his wife, Olga, is becoming stronger in Christ, and has taken responsibility to minister to the women. In the past, she hardly ever spoke out loud, but now Christ is giving her his boldness to share with others. The children Geiner, Joseh, y Zeti also work with them. They are working with our national missionaries, David and Mercy, in Boca Anapati, Yoyato, Camantabishi, and Pajonal. Thank you for your prayers for the leaders in this area, and please continue to pray that God will protect them and use them to advance His Kingdom!
