We praise the Lord God for all He is doing in our lives and in the ministry here in Peru, for filling us with His Holy Spirit to guide and direct each of our steps, and for pouring out His grace upon us through His precious Son, Jesus Christ. We hope that the Lord Jesus has been blessing you wonderfully during this past month, and that your life has been filled with His glorious riches and mercy. We are so thankful to God for you.

Beto went to Lima this month to renew his children’s DNI, or identification documents, and while he has there, he had the opportunity to meet with Paulo Baldarriaga, who has been in one Beto’s discipleship groups for a year. Paulo came to know about the group through Delia Ccora,

who was participating in the group. Last year Paulo and his fiancé contacted Beto because they wanted to talk about getting married. The conversation was interesting, but not very long after that, they broke their engagement because of differences and infidelity. This was a very hard time for both of them; however, Paulo continued to talk with Beto, and after several conversations, accepted the Lord Jesus Christ into his life. Paulo began to participate in a virtual discipleship group. While Beto was with him in Lima, he expressed a great desire to continue growing in his relationship with the Lord Jesus and to continue forgiving his fiancé. Paulo asked Beto if we could help him by continuing to pray for him.

Independence Day for Peru is July 28<sup>th</sup>, so Beto was able to go back to Lima to visit all of his children while they are on their two-week vacation. He works so hard; he deserved some time off. Please pray that God will give him a very restful time with his family.

The discipleship groups continue to meet on-line or in person, and they are going well; however, some of them are now studying different books of the Bible. The group that is learning to lead inductive Bible studies is studying Jude; and the other groups are studying the gospel of Mark, Philipians, or 1 John. Betsaida, one of Beto's disciples, has begun a new discipleship group in Huaras. They are still posting new audios of the Bible studies and devotions on-line too.

We are excited because Beto has found an agricultural engineer to help him evaluate and improve the soil and crops at the farm. Eder Vergaray, is a young man who had participated in

our first Kid's Club in Picheus, with his mother, Gladys, and his sister, Nicole, for years. Also, they participated in a discipleship group that Arthur led in our house too. It is so amazing to see how God can work through relationships that we have made over the years. Eder went to the farm for the first time this month with Beto and Ivan Cruz to do soil tests on the ground and to find ways to treat the funguses that have been attacking the crops. He enjoyed it a lot and is excited about continuing to help us on the farm.

This month the farm team finished the coffee harvest by selling 23 sacks of coffee, weighing 502 kilograms and 23 sacks of low-quality coffee (leftovers), weighing 505.70 kilograms. They earned S/8604.60 soles, which is about \$2220.00 dollars. The team has begun cutting the undergrowth of the coffee and is about one-half of the way finished with it.

The farm team is taking a short break from the chocolate bean harvest until they can get the beans that have been harvested dried and bagged. Until now they have harvested 1280 kilos, and the cost has remained the same this month at 7.30 soles per kilo.

The banana harvest started early, so the team has begun to harvest the bananas. So far, they have sold 539 kilograms at S/0.80 soles per kilo and have earned S/430 soles. The banana harvest will continue for several months.


## Prayer Requests and Praises for August
