They came prepared not only to provide medical care, but with a prayer team, children's ministry, and evangelism groups. The group provided medical care, dental care, and eye care. Approximately 700 attentions were given with 273 of these making first time professions of faith in the Lord Jesus Christ and 34 reconciling their life with Christ.
