Dear Brothers and Sisters in Christ,

Grace and peace to you from God our Father and from the Lord Jesus Christ. We praise the Lord God for all He is doing in our lives and in the ministry here in Peru, for filling us with His Holy Spirit to guide and direct each of our steps, and for pouring out His grace upon us through His precious Son, Jesus Christ. We hope that the Lord Jesus has been blessing you wonderfully during this past month, and that your life has been filled with His glorious riches and mercy. We are so thankful to God for you.

Praise the Lord! Arthur and Mary Alice got their second Covid-19 vaccine this month. We didn't have to wait very long at all, so we are thankful that we were able to get it. Thank you for your prayers for this. We also celebrated our thirty-eighth wedding anniversary on June 18th. God has blessed us both with each other. The time has really flown by quickly.

Arthur, Beto, Ivan, and Saúl went to the farm to supervise some work there and to begin the work necessary for the future construction of bathrooms and showers. They staked out the bathroom, septic system, and drain field to determine if there were any conflicts with the design that need to be addressed before construction. There were a few small conflicts which Arthur has addressed in the design. Ivan and Arthur, also, repaired the solar energy system that we already have on the farm and determined what additional capacity we will need.

Beto and Saúl inspected the work of the coffee team. The farm team sold 32 more sacks (3520 pounds) of coffee. Praise Jesus, the production of coffee this year will be slightly more than we had projected. The high season chocolate bean harvest will begin soon, so preparations were made for that, also.

In Huancayo, Ivan and Arthur continue to work on buying and preparing the materials needed to build the two bathrooms on the farm. The solar panels at the farm really haven't been providing enough electricity, so they bought and assembled another solar panel system to install, so that there will be more capacity to provide for the needs there. Also, they are working on the purchase of a small refrigerator, so that there will be a way to store some meat. The farm team is

doing a great job, so we are trying to make their life a little easier by providing these benefits. They have such an important job for the ministry! One way God is showing his faithfulness to us is by giving us success on the farm.

The discipleship leaders are continuing to conduct their groups online, so we are very thankful that God continues to use them. The discipleship groups are continuing to study the gospel of Luke and John, and about 152 people participate. There are groups on Monday, Thursday, Friday, Saturday, and three groups on Sunday. Antonella's group of youth in Huancavelica is continuing to grow. Beto stays very busy leading the discipleship ministry and the farm ministry. Please pray that God will protect him and the Peruvian leaders from Satan's attacks, and that God will continue to use them to advance His Kingdom.

One person that has participated in one of Beto's online discipleship groups since April 2020 is Cecilia Hernández. She has a very strong religious background, but also has a life with many deep hurts. While the group studied the Bible using the inductive Bible study method, she began to show that she had a close relationship with Christ. As a result, she began to share about Jesus

with some of her family and close friends. Margarita, her friend, is very thankful that Cecilia invited her to the group, and that the group has prayed for Margarita's family. It has been a blessing to her.

There is supposed to be a decision by July 15th. Right now there is a lot of instability, which could easily continue after the decision is made.


6. Please pray that God will continue to give the discipleship leaders and the key leaders His wisdom and everything they need as they minister to others.
