In March, Pastor Alberto, his wife, Karen, Arthur and Mary Alice went to La Merced to conduct another Leadership Retreat. It was a very good retreat with 15 leaders. Elena was a doctor that attended the group, and she gave us a very interesting perspective about physical illnesses. She said that many people that come to her for physical problems only need someone to listen to them and to care about them. When she does listen, many times God heals them. We have found that this is true during our medical campaigns, too. Many times just loving people heals them. We now have discipleship groups in San Ramon, La Merced, Puente Paucartambo and Villa Rica that were represented in this training event. Please pray that these leaders will continue to grow in Christ and if they haven’t begun their own discipleship group, that they will do so in God’s timing.

In addition, Arthur, Pastor Genaro Puente, and Pastor Johnny Vega finalized many details for the medical campaign that will be conducted in June in La Merced. Some of the people that will be sharing the gospel in the campaign are people that participated in the Leadership Retreat. The people in Genaro's and Johnny's discipleship's groups will be responsible for the follow-up of the people in the campaign that have accepted Christ and for the people that have interest in knowing more about Christ. Please pray that God will fill each of these people with the Holy Spirit as they do the discipleship. Also, please pray that God will help each Peruvian and American involved in the campaign to do their very best in the area where they will be working.

The discipleship ministry is continuing to grow. During the first three months of this year 300 more people began participating in this ministry, bringing us to a little more than 3800 participants. We praise God for how He is calling more and more people to be involved in this ministry, to grow in their relationship with Him, and to lead others into His Kingdom.

Also in March, a team from Covenant Methodist Church came and mainly worked with Ash and Audra McEuen in the library. They did go to the discipleship group that Arthur and Willy

have with the Shoeshine boys, and they attended and prayed with us in the Thursday night prayer meeting. One day they visited the Drums' ministry in Iscos, Tinyari, and Patarcocha. They all had copies of their testimonies in Spanish with their pictures on them, and they handed these out to many people. They said that they felt that many people were touched by these testimonies. We praise God for sending them and for using them to reach others for Christ.
