We have had two medical campaigns in this community in the past, so there are several discipleship groups there. Please pray that God will continue to raise up leaders in this community, and that the people will not worship the idol there, the Cani Cruz, anymore, but will worship the Lord Jesus Christ.

They are waiting to purchase these parts in order to leave space in our house to host two medical teams that will be here in July and August. If all goes well, the plan is for Arthur and Moisés to go to the farm in September to perform the field installation of the water system.

Unfortunately, Arthur's mother, Mildred Ivey, fell and fractured her ankle. She is wearing a type of boot while her ankle heals. Please pray that God will heal her as quickly as possible.

Please be in prayer for each one of our workers and for each one of the ministries and projects, the discipleship ministry, the evangelism and church planting ministry, the prayer ministry, and the work to self-sustain these ministries.

Please give praise to the Lord for bringing us additional persons called to be part of the missionary team in Peru. Covenant with us to continue in prayer for the young adult leadership team. Please pray for the leaders of the churches in Peru, and for their spiritual protection and growth in the Lord Jesus. Also be in prayer for Martin and Tracy Reeves, Tim and Jennifer Goshorn, and their families. All are missionaries with TMS Global that currently work in Peru.
