She has come to know Christ during this time, and she prays for Mary Alice and Marta each week because Mary Alice is training Marta how to evangelize. Janet continues to grow in Christ, and each night she has begun to pray with her husband, José, and her son, Christian. Arthur and I arrived in the states November 20<sup>th</sup> to share with as many people as possible about the work in Peru.
