We hope that everyone had a wonderful Thanksgiving and a blessed time with your family. We had a great time at Thanksgiving with our children and our grandkids at Santa Rosa Beach in Florida. Even though it was kind of cool, Dominic and Royce, Mary Beth's sons, especially enjoyed playing on the beach. We enjoyed just being together and playing some board games, as well as Twister. We don't have many opportunities to be all together for several days, so we are very thankful to God for that.

Beto and the discipleship leaders continued to conduct their discipleship groups mostly online; however, several groups have begun to meet in person. Antonella Huaranca's group of youth in Huancavelica and Beto's group of thirteen people in Pampas Ocopilla meet in person now. Also, Rubén Salvatierra has begun a new group in Angel's house in Auquimarca, that meets in person every fifteen days. There are approximately 118 – 132 participants that still participate online. They are studying the gospel of Mark, the gospel of John, Acts, or how to lead inductive Bible studies. For two days, Beto and Darwin conducted a leadership workshop for new believers in Auquimarca, where we conducted a medical campaign a few years ago.

Isabella, one of Beto's disciples, has published some Bible studies and devotions on YouTube. In addition she has been helping and praying with Eliane, a young girl who has been in a rehabilitation center for about two years because she has been addicted to alcohol and drugs. During her time there, she met a boy, got pregnant, and had an abortion. Also, this boy abused her verbally. Supposedly he shared the gospel with her, but she was very frustrated about her relationship with Jesus.

Isabella has developed a close relationship with Eliane, and she shared the true gospel of Jesus Christ with her. As a result, she accepted Jesus as her Savior and Lord and now participates in one of the online discipleship groups. She participates well in her group and asks a lot of questions. Please pray for Eliane because she still has a long way to go to be free from drugs and for discernment for Isabella, who is discipling her.

It has been raining a lot during the month especially in the jungle. This has delayed the cutting of the grass and undergrowth both around the cacao and coffee. The rain also delayed the fumigation of the coffee, which will now be done in December. The clearing and preparation for planting bananas was finished, and the workers are preparing the seedlings for transplanting. There will be a little over four hectares of bananas (4143 trees). We also had a small harvest of cacao.

Prayer Requests and Praises for December


1. Thank you for your prayers for Darwin Dávila, his sister, and his brother. They all have recovered from Covid-19 and are doing well.
