Hayde, one of the ladies that comes to Arthur's Friday night discipleship group wants to learn how to evangelize, so in the middle of October, Mary Alice began teaching her. This is one of Mary Alice's favorite things to do, so she is excited about it. We are glad that Brian Monda is also helping us evangelize when we go to the park. We went downtown to the park in Huancayo to evangelize the first week, and two people accepted Christ, and two people were already Christians. Arthur is starting an open Bible study, and we are going to invite the people that we evangelize to the group, as well as other people who might be interested in learning about Christ. Please pray that many people will accept Christ and will come to the open group, so that they can grow in their relationship with Christ.


