October was a very busy month for us. First of all, we went to Lima and picked up Louise Reimer, who will be working in Huancayo as a full time missionary with us. In Lima, she began the process of getting her visa. Also, we enjoyed taking her to the water park there, which has many beautiful fountains and even a laser show. She feels like God has called her to especially work with women in discipleship. She is doing very well, and her Spanish is improving daily. Please pray that God will continue to help her adjust to the altitude here, and that Jesus will guide her in His will each day.

In addition, a team from Covenant United Methodist Church, from Dothan Alabama came and worked with Billy and Laurie Drum in Tinyari. We enjoyed participating with them in the mornings as translators. Each morning for five days the team had activities for the children in four different areas: a Bible story, a health class taught by Laurie Drum, activities in sports, and a class where they listened to stories. The team showed them how to make a lot of neat crafts. Please pray that God will continue to move in a great way in San Juan de Iscos, Patarcocha, and

Tinyari, and that He will give His wisdom to Laurie and Billy Drum as they work with the people there.

Please pray that God will bless Luis and Carmen in their marriage and the ministry, and that they will continue to grow closer to Christ and closer to each other.
