Alberto, Darwin, and Pedro continue to disciple several groups of people. In October, the basic leadership workshop, as well as the True Identity workshop went very well. The Bible study that was based on the book of Acts was very interesting and is now finished. Also, in a disciple group in Cajas, a lady named Aurora, began to come to the group. She didn't know anything about the gospel, but after coming for a while, she gave her life to Jesus Christ. Now, this same discipleship group will begin to meet in her house.

Arthur and Mary Alice really enjoyed leading a workshop on healing prayer. Because of the number of people interested, the workshop was actually presented to two groups. The participants were very interested, and asked many good questions. Each of them will be prayed for in the next few months, so that they will be ready to observe a team praying for others. The goal is that in the future more teams of people will be ready to pray for others after they have practiced this method. Please pray that God will use this ministry to reach many people who need to be healed, to forgive others, and to reject lies that have been a part of their lives, so that they can be free and have a very intimate relationship with the Lord Jesus Christ, and can guide others to do the same.

The thing that is very important in this type of prayer is that the people listen to God. As a small example of this, Arthur asked the people in the group to invite God the Father to come be with them. They listened for a while, and this exercise affected a lady named Carmen very much. She began to cry and said that she really felt the Lord moving close to her and hugging her. Many times as we pray we have to be careful not to forget that one of the most important parts is taking time to listen to God.

The farm is continuing to improve. We harvested approximately two tons of cocoa this month, and this harvest will continue until late December. The trees are already blooming for the next harvest that will begin in late January of 2020. We were also able to finally get the stone we needed to finish the construction of the dryers. The stone has been placed in the dryers and the dryers are functioning at a much greater efficiency than before. Please continue to prayer for the Lord Jesus to give us abundant harvests.

We have also been investigating places for next year's medical missions. We have been contacting local officials to get their permission and letters of invitation to get the approval from the Ministry of Health. We have been evaluating places to hold the event, lodging for the teams and facilities for meal preparation. We have two places that will probably be for the events in June and August, and are still seeking Jesus's will for the July medical team. Please be in prayer for these preparations.

Please be in prayer for these upcoming November ministries:

1. Alberto will be leading a group each week on how to do an inductive Bible study. Please pray that those involved will understand the method and will be able to use it in their personal Bible study and in the mentoring of additional study groups.
2. A basic leadership workshop is planned for Cochas. Please pray that all will know the Lord Jesus Christ and will apply what they learned.
3. A micro-enterprise workshop is programmed for the last week of November led by Ricardo Nattery. Please pray that the people that come will be able to start their own business, and will use these businesses for Kingdom purposes.
4. We will hold a youth retreat for university students in Huancavelica. Please pray that many youth will come, will get excited about what Jesus is doing, will share with others about Him, and will become strong men and women of God.
5. Please pray that God will give His discernment to Arthur, Mary Alice, Alberto, Jhomara, and others who will be praying for each person who came to the healing prayer workshop and that each person will become free in Christ.
6. Please pray that the participants in Arthur's two discipleship groups will continue to grow closer to Christ and that God will use Marta and Mary Alice as they continue to evangelize others each week.

We will be visiting in the States for about three months starting in December of this year. We would like very much to visit as many of you as possible and share with you what the Lord Jesus has been doing in Peru. If you would like us to visit, please let us know so that we can schedule the time with you. Please be in prayer that we would have safe travel and would be able to visit with as many folks as possible.

Please be in prayer for each one of our workers and for each one of the ministries and projects, the discipleship ministry, the evangelism and church planting ministry, the prayer ministry, and the work to self-sustain these ministries. Please pray for the leaders of the churches in Peru, and for their spiritual protection and growth in the Lord Jesus. Also be in

prayer for Martin and Tracy Reeves, Paul and Kelly Wiegert, Tim and Jennifer Goshorn, and their families. All are missionaries with TMS Global that currently work in Peru. Please pray for our safety as we travel, and that we will boldly speak God's Word wherever we go.

We pray that Jesus will continue to give you hope to live each day for Him, and we also pray that God is drawing you closer and closer to Him every day. God bless you. We love you.
