After Beto returned to Peru in January, he prayed with them. They finally traveled and arrived in Santa Cruz January 31st.

A year ago, Saul decided to move to Santa Cruz, Bolivia, because he was able to study medicine there. He lived at the university paying a minimum amount for a room for himself. At the same time, he worked at a pharmacy to sustain himself. For these two last months, he returned to Peru to be with Maria, and they moved to Bolivia.

It is great that Saul and Maria are living together again! Maria is a nurse.

All the discipleship groups continue to meet either online or in person. Now, the majority of the people in the virtual groups are new and from different places in Peru and cities like Montevideo, Uruguay, Miami, Florida, Santa Cruz, Bolivia, Cartagena, Colombia, San Jose, Costa Rica, Milan, Italy, and Florencia, Italy.

The last week of January Edith Romero began a new discipleship group that meets in person in Antonella's house. The group consists of youth and will meet once a week on Fridays. Please pray that the Holy Spirit will lead Edith as she facilitates this group and that God will bear much fruit from the youth in this group.

In the middle of January, Marcos and Tabita began their trip from Caballococha and arrived at the farm February 2nd. It was a hard trip for them because of the rain and the bad conditions of the highways. They will be working with the farm team there full-time.

The farm team is continuing to try to finish building the new dryers for the cacao, but it has been difficult because of so much rain. The team harvested thirty-three buckets of cacao this month, and the cacao price has remained about the same, 16 soles per kilo. The electricity, the water, and internet are all working well at the farm.

The banana season finished in December, and Beto and the farm team decided to not continue planting them because the price for them is only about 60-70 centimos per kilo, which is a very low price.

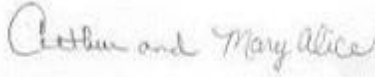
Prayer Requests and Praises for February
