Prayer is a very important part of the ministry in Peru. Each week a prayer guide is written, and at least two prayer groups meet together each week to pray through this prayer guide. One of

the groups meet in the Rodriguez family's house each week to pray, and at least fifteen other brothers and sisters ask Beto for the guide each week so that they can pray too. God continues to answer many of the prayer requests. Throughout our time in Peru, God has blessed us significantly doing many miracles, and we are so grateful for that.

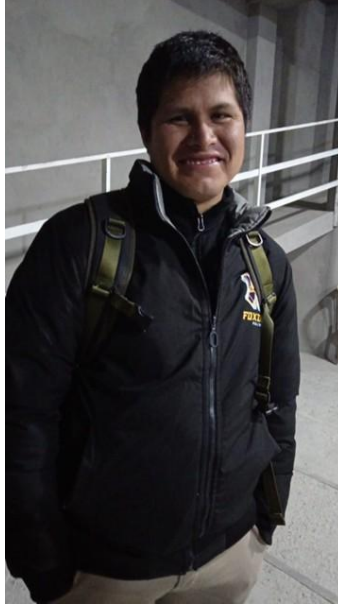
During the month of April Beto is registering people for two more discipleship groups that will meet together in person once a week to study the Bible, to learn the inductive Bible study method, and to prepare to disciple others. There are eighteen people in all, but they will be divided into two groups so that everyone will have more of a chance to be ministered to by others.

Under Edith Romero's and Antonella Huaranca's leadership in Hauncavelica, Beto shared in two workshops about Bible principles about marriage and the family. They studied Scriptures like Genesis 1-2, Malachi 2, Matthew 19:1-12, Ephesians 5, and 1 Timothy 2. There were twenty-four participants because there was a lot of interest from the people in small groups and from the Pentecostal Church of San Cristobal.

Martina is still in the recuperation process because of postpartum effects, and she needs to rest and be taken care of. Please pray that she will recover quickly and that the baby will continue to stay healthy.

The entire water filter system was wiped out from the flooding, and Beto is looking for someone to dig a well. Unfortunately, it is not easy to find a person to do it. Please pray that the rain will stop for now since it should be the dry season, that God will give us a great harvest of cacao, and that the price of cacao per kilo will increase, because it is very low right now. Also, pray that the road to the farm will be completely repaired as soon as possible.

Prayer Requests and Praises for May


