Although he seemed very worried because he didn't know what was going to happen with him, he was very encouraged to read the Bible and study it like he had never done before. He asked a lot of questions as he discovered Jesus through the Scriptures. It was obvious that there was a battle inside him between the lies that he had believed in the past and the truths that he was discovering in the present.

It was an exciting time for him, although he continued struggling with the lies that he had believed in his mind and heart. Kenye made a very good comparison of what his faith was before knowing Christ and the Scriptures by saying that before his faith was just a religion, but now he had a living faith, since he came to know the Lord Jesus Christ.

This encouraged Kenye to trust in the Lord for his future and the changes that were happening. God opened a door for a new and stable job for him, and although he was living for three weeks in the mine and then returning to rest for one week in Huancavelica, he took the responsibility to teach a youth group that meets in Antonella's house. Now, Kenye continues teaching with his wife, Martina, when they are in Huancavelica and also in a village called Acoria. Kenye and Martina are a young couple that continue to study in two virtual discipleship groups with Beto.

Beto visited Raul Roncal, who we have been praying for because he has leukemia. He has gone through a hard process of being in the hospital and chemotherapy. Even when Raul was in the hospital in Lima, he continued to participate in the virtual discipleship group on Mondays. Please pray that Jesus will continue to heal him.

Beto also visited Darwin Dadiva, who now lives in Pampa del Carmen in La Merced. During his time there, Beto conducted a leadership workshop teaching the Inductive Bible Study method. Sixteen people participated, and they learned a lot studying and sharing together. The discipleship virtual groups and in person groups continue to study and grow in their knowledge and love for the Lord Jesus too.

In August, since the farm workers were able to sell the 4100 kilos of cacao harvested at a better price, we had a better profit. There are serious problems with plagues that are attacking the cacao plants, but Juan Crispin is helping us to get rid of these. We won't be growing coffee anymore because we can't get enough workers. In November and December, we will finish with the banana harvest, and we have found a new buyer for them.

Since there has been a lot of flooding on the farm recently, the cacao dryers are not working as well. As a result, Arthur is designing a different kind of dryer like the coffee dryers. When he finishes designing them, the farm team will build two dryers to replace the original ones.

Prayer Requests and Praises for September


1. Thank you so much for praying for Arthur's health. It continues to improve.
