Dear Brothers and Sisters in Christ,

Grace and peace to you from God our Father and from the Lord Jesus Christ. We praise the Lord God for all He is doing in our lives and in the ministry here in Peru, for filling us with His Holy Spirit to guide and direct each of our steps, and for pouring out His grace upon us through His precious Son, Jesus Christ. We hope that the Lord Jesus has been blessing you wonderfully during this past month, and that your life has been filled with His glorious riches and mercy. We are so thankful to God for you!

The gospel is continuing to spread and affect many Peruvians' lives. Rosemeri came to know Jesus when she was a child, and when she was older, she became a teacher for kids in Sunday School, together with her sisters, Marleny and Liliana. She has always been dedicated to serving Christ. When the discipleship groups began to be online during 2020, Romeri and her family participated consistently. In April of 2023, Luis, her youngest son, became very sick with a liver problem. He was in the hospital for more than three months, and he had two surgeries. This was a very difficult time for Rosmeri, but her family continued to participate in the discipleship group from the hospital. The impact of Jesus' teaching was very strong in Rosmeri, and she continues to look for ways to serve Jesus, especially in her own family. For example, she has invited her brother, David, and his family to study the Bible with her. As people are faithful to disciple a few, the Gospel spreads

In June, Beto and some other leaders visited Jauja to prepare for the medical campaign that will be in August of this year. Even though the house church in Jauja is very small, the people were very excited to be able to be a part of this medical campaign. Erma Gonzales is the leader of the group in Jauja. We are praying that many people will come to know Jesus during the campaign. There will be medical attention and the opportunity to receive reading glasses for those who need them.

There was a big harvest of cacao this month, and the price in the market has fluctuated between 25.30 soles and 30.25 soles per kilogram. Because there is a chocolate shortage in Africa, this has helped the price to rise and has been a blessing to us.. The farm team sold 3772.4 kilos of cacao this month. Jorge, his father, Lucio, his brother, Lucio, Chayane, and Miguel Chavez are harvesting the cacao. Miguel will also be responsible for discipling the farm team, as well as discipling others in the area around the farm. Miguel is from Huancayo and worked with us for years in discipleship in Huamantanga. He and his family have been friends and coworkers in the faith for many years.

The farm team has finished harvesting the coffee, but need to clean the seven hectares by harvesting the poor fruit that remains on the plants. The banana plants continue to grow well and will need to be fumigated soon to prevent disease. Two Ashaninka brothers, Bernadino and his son, Angel, oversaw the coffee harvest this year.

Prayer Requests and Praises for July



It has been hard to find this person for Beto even though we have been looking and praying for 3 years now. Arthur has been filling this role until now, but it is not the same.
4. Please pray for Miguel Chavez, who will be working and living on the farm, as well as discipling the farm team and other people in the area.

5. Please pray that God will heal Arthur's brother, Joel, from colon cancer and that He will give strength to Arthur's mother, Mildred, as she has her pacemaker replaced on July 8th. Mildred is 97 years old, and this will be her third pacemaker. Also, pray for strength for Claudia, Arthur's sister, as she cares for them when we return to Peru.

Please be in prayer for each one of our workers and for each one of the ministries and projects, the discipleship ministry, the evangelism and church planting ministry, the prayer ministry, and the work to self-sustain these ministries. Please pray for the leaders of the churches in Peru, and for their spiritual protection and growth in the Lord Jesus. Also be in prayer for Tim and Jennifer Goshorn, and their family, who are missionaries with TMS Global that currently work in Peru. Please pray for our safety as we travel, and that we will boldly speak God's Word wherever we go.
