In the next few weeks, there should be a big harvest of cacao. The farm team is looking for all the cacaos that are ready to be harvested. They have harvested seventy-eight buckets in two weeks, which is about four hundred and sixty-eight kilos of dry chocolate beans. The market price of the cacao has gone up to thirty soles for one kilo.

The farm team is waiting to harvest the coffee in the next few weeks. They will be using a distinct process to process it. The beans will be dried without taking the pulp off of them. This type of coffee is becoming more popular.

The banana harvest has been more frequent in the past month and having William as the new buyer has helped tremendously, because in the past sometimes there wasn't a buyer for the bananas.

### **Prayer Requests and Praises for June**


