Moisés had gone to Spain to work for a while, but he arrived back in Peru just about the time that we needed someone to help Arthur fix up the house. We are thankful to God for him; he is capable of doing many different things and is a very honest, hard worker. Please pray that Moisés will see Jesus in us, and that he will grow in his relationship with Jesus, along with his daughter, Lissed, and his son, Brian, who live with him.

The pastors live in different parts of Peru, and were very interested in going through the discipleship materials, as well as starting their own discipleship groups. Please pray that these pastors will grow in their faith as they go through discipleship the first time, and that God will encourage them to start their own discipleship groups.

We had a very encouraging basic level leadership workshop in our house three days in September. Cinthia, a young lady who worked for us in the pharmacy in a medical campaign in Puerto Porvenir and also in Yuraj Marca, was part of the group. We could see the joy of Jesus in her beautiful smile. She brought her boyfriend, Charlie, to the group, and also her friend Begne, who worked in the medical campaign in Yuraj Marca. During the workshop Cintia even forgave her father for abusing her mother and her. She said that she felt much freer after she forgave her father. Charlie also forgave his biological father for leaving him when he was young.

There were other testimonies from the people that participated in the workshop that were very encouraging, too. Flavio, an older man, cried after he heard the gospel presentation, and said that he wished that he had accepted Christ a lot earlier in his life. He was very encouraged to be part of a small group, and said that it was what he was looking for. During the workshop he smiled more every day, as if God was giving him peace in his heart.

Alejandro, a pastor from San Pedro de Saños shared with us that his father was an alcoholic who abused his mother and him, but his father accepted Christ, and even asked Alejandro to forgive him for what he did. Alejandro also shared with us that 20 years ago he had third degree stomach cancer. His wife had a vision of God operating on her husband, so their children and she prayed that God would heal Alejandro. The doctors didn't want to operate on him, because they thought that he would die. Praise God that He healed Alejandro completely 20 years ago, and he still has no cancer.

Danny, who is Karen Garcia's brother-in-law, has been doing discipleship with Pastor Beto, and he shared about how important discipleship has been in his life. It was very obvious that he is growing rapidly in Christ. He would like to minister to youth, and is praying that God will give him some names of people that he can begin to get to know.

All these testimonies were evidence of how God is working in people's lives and setting them free. That is the purpose of discipleship, that people will grow in their relationship with Jesus and share that with others. If we allow Jesus to fill us with His Holy Spirit, as we teach others, rivers of living water will flow through us to help others.
